





Calorie-Trimmed Cranberry Treat

Festive fare on traditional Thanksgiving Day dinner tables will spell ruin to many a dieting plan. - Spiced Cranberry Salad** (Low-Calorie)
- 2 envelopes (or tablespoons) unflavored gelatin
 - 1 8 1/4-ounce can Sucaryl-sweetened pineapple tidbits
 - 2 cups raw cranberries
 - 2 1/2 cups water
 - 2 tablespoons Sucaryl solution
 - 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
 - 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg
 - 1/8 teaspoon cloves
- Soften gelatin in liquid drained from pineapple. Combine cranberries and water; cook until skins pop; force through food mill. Add to cloves, blending well. Refrigerate until mixture begins to thicken. Place drained pineapple tidbits in bottom of a 1-quart mold. Add thickened cranberry gelatin. Chill until set. Unmold and garnish with slices of pineapple, if desired.
