

# Varied Races to Feature Five-Day Surf Festival

Races for world-famous champions as well as champions of tomorrow will feature the 2nd annual International Surf Festival which begins today and runs through Sunday.

The five-day program will be sponsored by the Cities and Chambers of Commerce of Hermosa Beach, Manhattan Beach and Redondo Beach.

A highlight of the festival will be the Invitational Team

Surfing Championships, which will attract most of the outstanding surfing clubs in Southern California.

Preliminaries for the event will be held Saturday at 7 a.m. with the finals set for Sunday at 8 a.m. Trophy presentations will be held Sunday at 10:30 a.m.

More than 300 volleyballers will converge on Manhattan Beach Saturday and Sunday for the 7th annual Southern Municipal Athletic Federation Beach Volleyball Tournament.

PLAY WILL start at 10 a.m. both days and will be held on six beach courts on the south side of the Manhattan Beach pier.

John F. Shaw, superintendent of recreation for Manhattan, terms the tournament a "proving ground" for Olympic Volleyball Team selection. Volleyballers will be competing for individual awards as well as the chance to be scouted by national volleyball figures.

On Friday, a one-mile paddleboard race and the famed Taplin Relay Race will be held.

The paddleboard race will be held at 8:30 p.m. while the Taplin competition will begin at 9:15 p.m.

Both open and stock di-

vision will compete in the Paddleboard race. The open board are built especially for racing purposes and many of them are constructed of paper-thin cloth material built around a lightweight frame.

**THE THREE-MILE Taplin Race** will test the skills of the various lifeguard services throughout the Southern California area.

This event will be held in front of Lifeguard Headquarters, 1101 Strand, Redondo Beach, as will the paddleboard races.

The Taplin Relay is a 16-man relay with four swimmers, four paddleboard men and eight dory men, two men to a dory. As estimated attendance of 10,000 is expected for the race.
