

# Harbor JC Remains Unbeaten in Football

The Harbor JC Hawks, victorious over Pasadena 20-0 Friday night return to Casey Field for their Homecoming Game against the Los Angeles City Cubs Saturday night at 8 p.m.

The fireworks set off by the meeting might cause Harbor residents to think that the nearby Union Oil refinery has exploded. In LACC the Hawks will be meeting up

with the most spectacular offensive machine in the league.

Friday's game against Pasadena was put on the ice in less than two minutes in the second quarter as the Hawks scored two touchdowns on three consecutive plays. With Harbor leading by a slim 6-0 margin Pasadena was moving well in Harbor territory. An errant Pasadena pass was

picked off by safety man Haven Moses who sprinted 96 yards for the TD.

On the ensuing kickoff Pasadena fumbled and Sig Frawley recovered on the Pasadena 27. On the next play Don Horn passed to Stu Horn for another TD to put the icing on the cake. Blake more then passed to Steve Cox for the conversion.

Receiving the opening kickoff on their own 38-yard line, the Warriors put their new offensive into gear and rolled 62 yards in seven plays for a TD. The score came on a 29-yard pass from Bob Johnson to Jon Fowler. Otto Rieger added the PAT and the Warriors led, 7-0.

Then things started to happen to the Warriors — and none of them were good. Cerritos left the field with 20-7 advantage at intermission.

Cerritos scored again on the first scrimmage play of the second half to make it 26-7.

El Camino didn't score again until the final 43 seconds of the game, when Bill Daquila hit Ed Pease with a 40-yard touchdown aerial.

The victory was sweet revenge for the Falcons who have lost to EC two years in a row.

East Los Angeles will also be looking for revenge in visiting Murdock Stadium. The Elans were humiliated by the Tribe last year, 54-6.

EC owns an 11-6 edge over the Huskies in a series that began in 1947 and has won the last six games, dating back to 1958.

On the season, the Huskies have a 1-3 record. Their lone win was a 14-6 triumph over Pasadena but they have lost to Glendale, 22-6, San Diego, 21-0 and Valley, 26-6.

Coach Bill Thompson runs his forces out of the shifting "I" offensive alignment. This allows him to use Paul Parque, a converted quarterback, at wingback.

Art Arzate handles the quarterbacking chores for the Huskies and has established himself as a fine passer. Against San Diego the former All-City whiz from Garfield High connected on 24 of 40 passes for 215 yards.
