AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF TORRANCE AMENDING APPENDIX I OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, (ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 791, RECLASSIFYING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION CASE NO. 64-65. (Vernal A. Smith) WHEREAS, the City Council deems that it is to the public interest to change the zoning classification of certain real property in the City of Torrance as hereinafter described to Section 2 (as applied for in Planning Commission Case No. 64-65)...

SECTION 1. That the City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby find and determine that the Change of Zone applied for in Planning Commission Case No. 64-65 more particularly described in Section 3 hereof is necessary for the preservation and enjoyment of substantial property interests of the owners of property in the vicinity thereof; that said Change of Zone will not be detrimental to the public welfare or to the property in the vicinity thereof; that notice has been given to the owners of property in the vicinity thereof and public hearings have been duly and regularly held, all as required by Appendix I of the Code of the City of Torrance, 1954...

SECTION 2. 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Garden Checklist

- 1. Remove spent annuals and replant with winter blooming varieties such as pansy, viola, calendula and stock.
2. Renew worn spots in the lawn by spiking the area, loosening the soil and sowing new seed. Cover with peat moss and be certain to keep damp until new growth is established.
3. Lift and store gladioli when the tops have faded to yellow or brown.
4. Divide crowded perennials such as Shasta Daisy and phlox. Daylilies are happier if left undivided.
5. Plant ranunculus and anemones. They need less protection from marauding birds when their top growth starts early.
