Concert Date Selected By South Bay Symphony

Amparo Iturbi will be featured at the piano when the South Bay Civic Symphony presents a concert at the Redondo Union High School Auditorium Nov. 20.

The symphony, under the baton of Elyse Aehle, will perform compositions by Mendelssohn, Sebelius, Von Weber, and Chopin.

Miss Aehle, founder of the symphony, has served as its conductor for 20 years. She has toured as a guest conductor of many famous symphonies and has been cited by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors for her service to the community.

She also received a national citation for her musical work abroad. Miss Aehle, a concert artist in her own right, has performed on radio and has been acclaimed as

the most outstanding woman musician by her native state of Missouri.

The South Bay Civic Symphony, with a membership of 70 to 90, appears in a wide variety of concerts and shows. It numbers among its members five concert masters, college teachers, and other well known artists.

New musicians are welcome to rehearsals, which are held each Monday evening at Redondo High School and each Thursday evening at Morningside High School.

Among the outstanding annual programs of the symphony are the Three Day May Festival of Art, a 16-year-old program, and the annual Christmas Masque, a feature of the Christmas seasons here for 13 years.




