The instant, painless testing program, designed for all age groups, is sponsored by the Diabetes Assn. of Southern California. Goal of the program is to locate the more than 50,000 unknown diabetics in the Los Angeles area, according to Mrs. William Faulds and Mrs. R. E. Moffitt, health chairman.

"Our members are anxious to assist in this important health project, which takes place throughout the country during Diabetes Detection Week, Nov. 15 to 21," stated presidents of both clubs.
