Form into 1/2-inch round balls. Dip in egg white and roll lightly in chopped nuts. Place on greased cookie sheets; press 1/2 candied cherry in center of each. Bake at 325 degrees for 20 minutes. Makes 2 1/2 to 3 dozen cookies.

SNOWBALLS
1 cup butter
1/2 cup sugar (powdered, sifted)
1 tsp. vanilla
2 1/2 cups sifted flour
1/4 tsp. salt
1/4 cup chopped nuts

Mix butter, powdered sugar and vanilla; sift together flour and salt and add to first mixture. Add nuts, mix well. Chill dough. Roll into 1-inch balls. Place on ungreased cookie sheet. Bake at 350 degrees. While warm roll in powdered sugar. Cool and re-roll in powdered sugar.

DANISH KLEINERS
2 egg yolks
1 whole egg
1/2 tsp. sugar
1/2 tsp. cream
Pinch of Cardamom

Mix all of the above ingredients, adding enough flour to make a soft dough. Roll thin on board, cut into 3x1 inch strips, cut an inch slit in middle and draw one end through the hole. Deep fry until brown, approximately two minutes. Cool slightly, then dip or cover with powdered sugar.

CHOCOLATE SUGAR BALLS
1/2 cup chocolate chips
1/2 cup light corn syrup
1/2 cup orange juice
2 1/2 cups vanilla wafers (crushed)
1/2 cup powdered sugar
1/2 cup nuts (chopped)

Melt chips over hot (not boiling) water. Remove from heat and add syrup and juice. Combine wafers, powdered sugar and nuts. Add the chocolate mixture and mix well. Let stand for 30 minutes; form into 1-inch balls: Roll in sugar. Let ripen in a covered container for several days. Makes about 4 1/2 dozen cookies.
