

One of the most durable characters in postwar entertainment is "Mister Roberts," the harassed executive officer on a supply ship caught in the backlash of World War II.

The part is so skillfully drawn that it holds the entire play together. It was made into a movie and now it is to be a television series starring one of the medium's most engaging young performers, Roger Smith, whose best known address was "77 Sunset Strip."

He dropped into tell me about his good fortune last week. He's a pleasant, attractive chap with a fine smile and a lot of characteristics that should make him an excellent Navy officer, Hollywood style. We'll find out for sure next year. Shooting starts in January.

For Smith, the new role completes a story that began in Hawaii years ago. "I was able to pick up some extra money by playing the ukulele and singing. During that time they came out to film 'Mister Roberts' and I remember I would have given anything for an extra part in the movie, but didn't make it. I could never have dreamed I would one day play the role on television."

SMITH'S BIG break was in the Warner Brothers' movie "Auntie Mame," where he played the role of Rosalind Russell's nephew, whose big line, as I recall, was "Gee, Auntie Mame—long pants!"

"After the film was made I was still under contract, so they threw me into '77 Sunset Strip.' I was willing to go on suspension to avoid television. When I was given the script I didn't know whether I was to play 'Kookie' or Jeff."

Although Smith does not discredit "77 Sunset Strip"

as an important part of his career, he appears happy to be out of the rut that he found himself in as the junior detective to Efrem Zimbalist Jr. and the chum of the "Kookie" parking lot attendant, Edd Byrnes.

"Yep, I finally escaped the trio, he said. 'I was the first of the sand-box detectives you know, the junior eye. Most of the time I stood around and said, 'Yes, ma'am' or 'Thank you, ma'am' and opened doors for people in trouble. I got the young clients, you recall. That was one thing I can say about '77 Sunset Strip'—they never showed blood and they never gave me old clients."

TWO SEASONS ago when Jack Warner sacked his son-in-law, William T. Orr, as head of TV production and replaced him with Jack Webb, several drastic changes were made in "77 Sunset Strip"—among them was to drop all regulars except Zimbalist and hire expensive guest stars with the money they saved. It killed the show.

Early this year Smith was offered the title role in "Mr. Broadway," but turned it down. "It was the same old stuff and I wanted to escape it so I took a road show part in 'Sunday in New York' to get away from Hollywood until there was a meaningful role for me. One night I was making a curtain speech in Brookfield, Wisconsin, and got a lot of laughs and a lady who owned a night club asked me to do a one-man show. That's how I got to the hungry I."

"It turned out to be my biggest break yet. Some studio people came up from California—excuse me, I mean L.A. This doesn't seem like California—and now I'm going back to Warner Brothers in real style with a show of my own. It's a good feeling. If I had stayed in L.A. it never would have happened," he said.

"Roberts is a quiet role. He doesn't say much. It will be quite a change from my last TV show. You can say a lot about '77 Sunset Strip,' but you can't say we were ever at a loss for words!"
