Carson Man Home From South Pole

Airman I.C. Miles M. Anderson, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert F. Anderson of 1700 E. Carson St., Torrance, has completed his work with this year's "Operation Deep Freeze" in the South Pole region and is scheduled to return to his permanent duty station at Travis AFB, Calif., in time for Christmas.

Airman Anderson, an aircraft mechanic, is part of the 150-man U.S. Air Force task force which concluded its annual resupply of scientific stations on the frozen continent of Antarctica.

Since mid-October, Military Air Transport Service C-130 Hercules aircraft flown by the airman's unit have completed 25 missions in the world's worst flying weather to deliver cargo and passengers from Christchurch, New Zealand, to the ice runways at McMurdo and Hallett Stations, Antarctica.

A graduate of Culver City High School, the airman attended Los Angeles Harbor Junior College, Wilmington, Calif.
