

At El Camino

Spring Registration Set in Early February

Registration for the spring semester at El Camino College will be held Feb. 1 to 5 in the campus Communications Center. All students must comply with state law regarding immunization for poliomyelitis. Forms for this purpose are available at the college registration office. Reservations for registration by entering full or part-time students may be obtained at the college. No student will be permitted to register unless he has a reservation. All students who register will be required to pay a student fee of \$3. Out-of-state residents are required tuition fees of \$10.20 per unit to a maximum of \$153. Transcripts of high school and previous college work are required of all full-time students and those part-time students who seek counseling. Questions about registration procedure will be answered by the registration office, DA 4-6631.

Bank of America Reports Record Earnings in 1964

Record earnings of \$99,625,233 or \$3.50 per share have been reported by the Bank of America for the fiscal year which ended Dec. 31, 1964. Total resources for the bank rose to \$15,498,892,008, an increase of more than \$805 million over fiscal 1963. The bank also reported outstanding loans of \$9.2 billion and deposits of \$14 billion during the year.

At year-end, Bank of America operated 871 branches in California and 27 overseas branches. The bank also has 12 representative offices and interests in banks and other financial institutions in 22 nations. Rudolph A. Peterson, president of the bank, said investments in securities now total \$3,197,948,529. Dividends totaling \$56,960,000 were paid to more than 200,000 shareholders at the annual rate of \$2 per share.

Area Banks Open DMV Stations

Four area banks have been listed by the Department of Motor Vehicles as renewal stations between now and the Feb. 4 deadline for 1965 vehicle registrations.

Tom Bright, director of the department, said the banks would process applications not requiring transfer of ownership or other complex transactions.

Banks which will be open to service renewal applications include: Gardena Bank of America, 1030 W. Gardena Blvd., Lawndale Bank of America, Redondo Beach Boulevard and Hawthorne Avenue, Wilmington Bank of America, 108 W. Anaheim St., and Redondo Beach Bank of America, 200 N. Pacific Ave.

New Rates Announced On Savings

United California Bank has announced an increase in interest rates on all savings accounts to 4 per cent daily interest, retroactive to Jan. 1, 1965.

The new 4 per cent rate is the highest ever authorized for banks by federal authorities, according to Frank L. King, chairman of the board of United California Bank. The rate has been permissible since late November. Interest on savings accounts will be figured on a daily basis and paid and compounded quarterly, King said. The new rate will apply to all savings accounts. Prior to Jan. 1, the bank has paid 4 per cent on accounts held for a year or more and 3.5 per cent on regular savings accounts.



Very soon now your nursery will be getting in its bare root stock of trees. It would be a good idea to look them over and select yours early while he still has the better ones available.

If you are bothered with borers in your soil it would be well to treat the ground with Ethylene dichloride solution before planting.

Be sure you plant your trees far enough apart so that you will not have to remove some of them in a few years. I tell you this every year but it is most important. It would be well to pace off the diameter of the grown tree and see if you have room enough.

Soak the tree ball in a Vitamin B1-hormone solution before planting and you will find that the tree will get off to a better start.

It is always a good idea to consult your local nurseryman or county agent before deciding on the type of tree you buy, whether it be for shade or fruit. Local climate and soil are big factors in your success with trees.

Trees not only provide much satisfaction to you but they add many dollars to the value of your property.

Telephone Employees Offer Aid

Employees of the Pacific Telephone Co. in the Los Angeles central area have pledged \$444,557 in charitable contributions for 1965, according to J. P. Leggett, local manager.

The contributions are made through the Associated In-Group Donors (AID) plan of the United Givers' campaign through payroll deductions. More than 89 per cent of the firm's employees have signed pledges, Leggett said. The 1965 total pledge is about \$38,000 more than last year.
