Officers Named by New Horizons Board

Hon. William E. MacFaden, judge of the superior court in Los Angeles County, has been elected chairman of the Board of Governors of New Horizons, according to George Lavac, recreational director.

With the election of Judge MacFaden and other officers of the board, organization of the self-government of the "city within a city" is complete, Lavac said.

New Horizons is Ray Watt's adult recreation and garden home community which recently became the first major Southland adult condominium to elect its own Board of Governors and to turn administrative control over to the residents, Lavac explained.

Elected vice chairman was Harry L. Battagliola, an engineer. Other officers are

Randa Presley, secretary; William D. Paul, treasurer; Ruth Geer, assistant secretary, and Gene Caprio, assistant treasurer.

Committee assignments include Harold Todd, public grounds and maintenance; Bill Paul, recreation buildings and pools; Armand Berges, taxes, insurance and finance; Jack Wilson, activities and recreation; Gene Caprio, resi-

dents, and Harry Battagliola, executive and rules.

The Board of Governors of New Horizons meets each Tuesday night to conduct the affairs of the private community.

Residence in the all-adult community is limited to families with one spouse or single persons at least 35. No children under 18 may become permanent resident.



B of A Plans New Branch In Dominguez

Bank of America will establish a branch in the Dominguez Hills area of southwestern Los Angeles County, it was announced by Vice President James F. Naughton.

Naughton, who is the senior officer in the area, said the new branch will offer a full range of banking services to Dominguez Hills residents and businessmen.

The bank has leased 1,520 square feet of space for the branch in a shopping center at 18513 S. Avalon Blvd., he said.

According to a recent report made by the Los Angeles County Planning Commission, Dominguez Hills is one of three areas in southwestern Los Angeles County most likely to undergo rapid residential development on presently vacant or agricultural lands.

NAUGHTON REPORTS the current population is 9,500—a 71 per cent increase over the 1960 census figure. Future residential developments indicate that by 1975 the population will increase to 40,900.

"Despite its present rate of residential and industrial expansion and excellent prospects for diversified future growth, Dominguez Hills is without local banking facilities," Naughton said.

"This new branch will enable us to provide complete banking service in modern quarters at a location convenient for all."

Although no target date has been set for the start of construction, every effort will be made to get the branch operating as soon as possible, Naughton concluded.
