Cabrillo Compounds Rates Daily

Interest paid on savings accounts at Cabrillo Savings will be compounded daily, effective Oct. 1, according to Pietro DiCarlo, chairman of the board.

The new policy will provide a return of 4.97 per cent, based on maintenance of the current rate of 4.85 per cent for one year, DiCarlo said.

Loan volume during the past quarter reached \$1,916,100, according to a report by Fred Strohmeier, executive vice president of Cabrillo Savings. Assets of the association are now \$19,490,000.

The board of directors will continue to pay the "instant interest" bonus which enables funds to earn from the date of receipt. Funds received by Monday, Oct. 11, will earn from Oct. 1 DiCarlo said.
