Coral Sea played a major role in the reprisal strikes over North Viet Nam on Feb. 7 and 11. This is the first liberty port for the carrier's crew since Jan. 16, when the Coral Sea departed Pearl Harbor, Hawaii to become a unit of the U.S. Seventh Fleet in the Far East.
