

Schools Salute Law Day

Nearly 600 schools in the Los Angeles City System will place special emphasis on law this week as the school participate in the annual observance of Law Day USA.

Law Day, which falls on Saturday, is designed to foster a deeper respect for law by teaching how laws serve all citizens.

It was established by Congress in 1961 as a permanent national observance and is sponsored by the American Bar Association and local bar associations.

"THIS EVENT provides a special opportunity for schools to emphasize the great principle of individual freedom under law in the United States and to contrast this principle with the denial of human rights under totalitarian governments," said Superintendent of Schools Jack P. Crowther.

Possible school activities during the week would include class discussions and student essays on such topics as what individuals can do to develop respect for law and order and the rights and responsibilities of United States citizens.

IN ADDITION, classes can learn about the evolution of law in the United States by reviewing such historical documents as the Declaration of Independence, the Constitution and the Bill of Rights, Crowther noted.

Earlier this month, the city schools sent a special pamphlet on respect for law to parents of all elementary school pupils in the district. The pamphlet stressed the joint role parents and school have in building respect for law.

Educators To Retire From Posts

Hobart C. Uhis and Lloyd W. Waller, two of California's most respected educators, will be honored at a retirement dinner Wednesday, May 12, at the Redondo Beach Elks Club.

The veteran educators are retiring after a total of 83 years as educators—75 of it in the South Bay Union High School District.

Waller is now principal at Mira Costa High School, while Uhis serves as principal at Aviation High School.

UHIS JOINED the South Bay Union District in 1923 and served as athletic director at Redondo High School until 1950. He became boys' vice principal at Mira Costa in 1950, then headed the group which developed Aviation High, becoming principal there when the school opened in 1957.

Waller, who was principal and superintendent of schools in Fairfax, Mo., joined the Redondo High staff as a coach. He left the area in 1928 to accept a position in the St. Joseph, Mo. schools.

HE RETURNED to Redondo in 1929 and brought the Seahawks their first championship in 1930. Waller has held numerous posts in the South Bay Union District, helped to organize El Camino College, and was principal of Torrance High in 1948. He headed the group developing Mira Costa High School in 1948 and became Mira Costa principal in 1950.
