Oregon Voters May Pass On Property Tax Ceiling

What this has meant is what you might expect. As the Monitor commented, "Almost always Oregonians vote 'no' on new or higher taxes."

However, I think a significant comparison can be made as to the relation between state and local burdens and personal income.

Actually, I would oppose a one per cent property tax limit because I feel it is unrealistically low.

Complicating Oregon's tax picture is its unique constitutional provision that any revenue measure initiated by the legislature must be submitted to a popular vote.
