LAS VEGAS—In all of my travels to such places as London, Paris, Rome, Madrid, Moscow, Tokyo, and of course many small towns in between—it had never crossed my mind to go to Las Vegas, Nevada. Anyway, here we are. The weather is beautiful—the place is crowded—and I just can't believe it.

It was exciting to invade Princesses Grace's Monte Carlo and play the part of a big spender at the roulette and dice tables. But even the ordinary casinos here in Las Vegas put Monte Carlo to shame. For my money—it's the Hotel Sahara when it comes to gambling. They take your money with charm and elegance.

The French seem to have taken over the top shows on the "strip." In addition to the "Lido de Paris Revue," there's the "Casino de Paris" at the Dunes Hotel (check their neon sign—it's one of the best there.) The famous (highly overrated) "Folies Bergere" is being exposed at the Tropicana—and

they were turning the crowds away there too.

GIOVANELLA is the name of a young American artist whose work has principally been done in Spain and Mexico. She has been written up in Time magazine and numerous other publications with much fanfare and ballyhoo. A showing of her paintings is being held in the lobby of the Tropicana Hotel.

Can't see what all the fuss is about. What infuriates me no end is the sly comparison of an artist to a master of the past. In this case they have signs comparing her work (in so many words) to Goya, the incomparable Spaniard, and to Rembrandt, of all people. Poor taste, mixed with a dash of ignorance can account for this.

The other paintings in the Tropicana are less than average in quality—someone with a little knowledge and interest should be put in charge. Actually—I suppose that no one is really interested in paintings in Los Vegas—at least not with gambling, drinking, and shows to see.

Psychiatric Facilities Inadequate

Concern due to overcrowded conditions and lack of adequate facilities in the psychiatric holding areas at Los Angeles County General Hospital has been expressed by Supervisor Kenneth Hahn. On Hahn's motion the Board of Supervisors has asked Superintendent of Charities Bill Barr and Chief Administrative Officer Lindon Hollinger to work out a program to improve conditions. During the discussion before the board, Hahn noted that the Cedars of Lebanon and Mt. Sinai hospitals are combining their facilities and the Mt. Sinai Hospital might be made available to the county to relieve overcrowding at General Hospital. Hahn asked for a complete study on possibilities of obtaining this facility.
