Herman G. Link was installed Saturday as manager of the Sears, Roebuck and Co.'s retail store here. He succeeds George G. Gaugler who has been promoted to manager of the Sears, Roebuck and Co.'s retail store in the Ala Moana Shopping Center in Honolulu.

### Gas Pipeline Being Built

Construction is under way on Southern California Gas Co.'s 4.3-mile, 30-inch pipeline which will reinforce natural gas supplies to Southwest Los Angeles.

The \$800,000 project will take approximately 60 days with the completion date set for June 30.

The pipeline will run from Jefferson Boulevard and Centennial Avenue to 104th Street and Aviation Boulevard where it will tie into the 30-inch line which completely encircles Los Angeles.




