Local Plant Gets Order To Erect German Facility

Torrance Specialty Fixtures, a local machinery building firm and a subsidiary of P & F Industries of Syosset, N.Y., has just received an order for a pipe manufacturing plant from Hoesch A.G. of Dortmund, Germany.

The pipe mill will be the largest continuous pipe mill in Europe and will produce pipe from 6-inch to 24-inch diameter for oil, gas, and water pipe lines.

Torrance Specialty Fixtures "Torrance" pipe mills are in operation in many countries around the world and Germany will now be added to countries such as Belgium, Israel, France, England, Argentina, Italy, South Africa, Mexico, Canada, etc., as well as several in the U.S.

Over half of T.S.F. sales are to foreign countries and thus directly aid in bringing dollars back to the U.S.

THE PIPE plant for Hoesch A.G. will be built from T.S.F. engineering with some of the machinery being built in Ger-

many, but substantially over 50 per cent will be built in the T.S.F. plant in Torrance, C. A. Babbitt, president of T.S.F., said.

Orders for Chemicals Filled Here

Orders for industrial products valued at \$96,000 have been filled by two Torrance firms, the U.S. Agency for International Development reported today. The goods have been sold to Turkey and South Korea under U.S. foreign aid financing.

Shell Chemical Co. filled an order for synthetic rubber. The rubber, valued at \$77,000, was shipped to Turkey.

A \$19,000 order for polyethylene resin was filled by Union Carbide Corp., Chemical Division. It was shipped to South Korea.

THE NEW factory will be built in Hamm, Germany, and will incorporate in its design many new developments of T.S.F.

This new mill will not be the largest mill built by the local firm as it has already built and has in operation two mills that produce 36-inch pipe continuously, which mills are by far the largest mills of their type in the world. One of these is in Canada and the other in Mexico and both are operating successfully.


