

## 'For Sale' Sign Put on South Woodshop Project

Four South High students have completed a small playhouse as part of their carpentry project in a woodworking shop class this semester. The playhouse, which measures 8 feet by 8 feet, is now up for sale.

Constructed by Steven Donatoni, Peter Henry, Dennis O'Doud, and Otis Tucker, the playhouse is made of redwood siding and has a shingled roof. The interior is finished with drywall and matched floor.


The playhouse features three frame windows, gingerbread trim, and a mahogany dutch door. It is wired for electricity and has a flush ceiling fixture and two wall outlets.

The woodshop course covers many aspects of wood-working. It includes a study of tools, materials, and processes of machine woodworking, cabinetmaking, carpentry, patterns, and boat building.

Students in advanced classes work on projects of their own choosing to develop vocational skills which may help them to get jobs once they have finished school. They also study related areas.

Instructor William Maley said he attempts to teach students to "work with accuracy and precision and to appreciate good design and craftsmanship."

Purpose of the banquet is to honor outstanding students for their achievements in specific fields of classroom and extra-curricular activities. Awards will be given in 21 subject areas and activities other than inter-scholastic athletics.

Nominees were selected by the various departments at school.

AWARDS WILL be presented in art, business, drama, English, foreign language, Girls' Athletic Association, home economics, industrial arts, journalism, leadership, mathematics, music, physical fitness, boys' and Girls' physical education, science, social science, speech, work experience, and service to school (two awards, one for boys and one for girls).


Masaki and other graduating seniors were honored at the USC Pharmacy Alumni Association's annual banquet.
