

Moose Convention Opens June 20 in Los Angeles

Television funnyman Danny Thomas will be honored at a huge new member class enrollment ceremony June 20 during the annual convention of the Loyal Order of Moose. More than 2,500 persons are expected to be initiated in the largest display ever held in Los Angeles. Moose fraternal leaders have doubled space arrangements and now expect to use all three major convention hall at the Biltmore Hotel.

The event will mark the opening of the 77th international convention of the Loyal Order of Moose, being held in Los Angeles for the first time in the order's history. Thomas is co-chairman of the event and will share duties with James B. West of Encino, Calif.

RIVIERA MOOSE Lodge 1873 of Redondo Beach expects to be part of the performance, according to Robert L. Gipson, governor of the lodge. Gipson said 70 Moose lodges in the greater Los Angeles area will cooperate during the ceremonies and the convention.

Redondo Beach Mayor William F. Czuleger and Richard S. Fitzgerald, manager of the Redondo Beach Chamber of Commerce, will attend the convention. They will be joined by A. Roger Sailors, city attorney for Redondo Beach.

The convention, which is scheduled to end June 24, will feature the International Quartette competition, a party for the 25-Club, 26 ritual teams competing for the international championship, and "Moose Day" at Disneyland, Gipson said.

City Plans More Drain Facilities

Approval of an engineering agreement between the City of Torrance and the County Flood Control District has been announced by Supervisor Kenneth Hahn.

The agreement, which will lead to construction of additional storm drain facilities, calls for the city to design a "supplemental" 1958 bond issue storm drain to be financed out of savings on "regular" projects built under the \$225 million program.

Known as the Torrance drain, the alignment is tentatively set to begin in Dominguez Avenue at Crenshaw Boulevard, run south in Crenshaw to Maricopa Street, west in Maricopa to Maple Avenue, south in Maple to Sonoma Street, and west in Sonoma to Florwood Avenue.

Following completion of plans, the district will issue an invitation for bids and the drain will be built by a private contractor under the agency's jurisdiction.

Pastor Is Honored At Harbor

A dinner honoring the Rev. Floyd McWhinney, senior minister of Harbor Church, was held following the 11 a.m. worship service Sunday.

Mr. McWhinney is completing 41 years of active gospel ministry, a ministry that began in the midwest and led to the establishment of more than 20 Assemblies of God congregations.

The Rev. Robert Pruett conducted the service with music furnished by the Harbor Trio. The church is located at 1032 W. Pacific Coast Highway.

Road Work Is Underway

County Road Department projects costing more than \$75,000 are under way in the Carson area according to Supervisor Chairman Burton W. Chace.

Installation of traffic signals and highway safety lighting at Avalon Boulevard and Scottsdale Drive is part of a \$5,144 contract awarded to Steiny-Mitchel, Inc.

Another project, the \$28,500 improvement along portions of Figueroa Street, is progressing on schedule. This work includes curbs, gutters, pavement and sidewalks in vicinity of Martinshire, from 223rd to 235th Streets.


