



Realty Board Adopts CREA Housing Code

A new handbook giving guidelines for achieving equal opportunity in housing has just been furnished by the California Real Estate Association to its 175 member real estate boards, it was announced by Albert Z. England, president of the Torrance-Lomita Board of Realtors.

"Our board has adopted the CREA recommended Code of Practices, which is in the handbook," England said. "We feel it states our position clearly when the race, color, or religion of a prospective buyer, seller or renter becomes a factor in a housing transaction."

He added that while the property owner has freedom of choice in selecting the buyer or renter of his property, the booklet points out that the real estate agent cannot do so of his own accord. "We must act according to the instructions of the owner," he said.

ENTITLED "Equal Rights Handbook," the booklet discusses guidelines concerning the legal and moral responsibilities of the real estate broker. The foreword "dedicates this handbook in the spirit of earnestly seeking equal opportunity for all in the acquisition and use of real estate in California."

"This is how we feel. We are ready to work with other responsible groups whenever there seems to be a problem in this area," England said.

He said the Torrance-Lomita Board has also established an Equal Rights Committee, recommended in the new handbook, specifically to work with other responsible organizations.
