
The pastor will relate some of his early experiences as pastor in Redondo Beach and the highlights of his ministry which has reached throughout the world through missionaries of the church tract.

Quick Action On Change of Mail Advised

Veterans or the dependents of veterans receiving compensation or pension payments from the Veterans Administration should report immediately any change of address to avoid delay in receipt of their benefit checks, according to Mort Webster, manager of VA's Southern California Regional Office.

VA officials said that both the old and the new address should be given in notifying the VA of the fact that they had moved. In addition, it is always well to file a change-of-address card with the local post office.

The VA receives thousands of letters each month including many which cannot be answered because the writer fails to identify himself with address or claim number. The writer's full name, the address and the "C" number (or insurance number) should always be included, Webster said.
