

Harbor Freeway Gets New Emergency Phones

Designed to provide fast help to motorists in trouble, a brand-new first-of-its-kind emergency telephone system is in operation on a 10 mile stretch of Harbor Freeway. Hahn said.

In cooperation with county officials, Pacific Telephone Co. has completed installation of 80 telephone call boxes on opposite shoulders of the freeway between the Santa Monica Freeway interchange and El Segundo Boulevard.

Unlike the radio call box plan now in use on the central city portions of the Harbor, Santa Ana and Hollywood Freeways, the new emergency system provides direct two-way voice communications between the freeway telephone and the dispatch board of the Los Angeles Police Department.

INSTALLATION of the phones, on a one-year trial basis, was approved Feb. 2 by the County Board of Supervisors on motion of Supervisor Kenneth Hahn.

Hahn, who for the past 10 years has pressed for such an emergency system, said the phones would fulfill a vital need to summon help for motorists in the event of accident or mechanical breakdown.

"It doesn't make sense to build the finest freeway system in the world when a flat

tire can jam it up and waste hours of time for motorists trying to get to and from work and appointments," Hahn said.

BY ACTUALLY speaking to the person reporting an accident, Hahn said, the police dispatcher can determine immediately the type and amount of equipment to be sent to the scene.

Hahn said the phones are placed at quarter mile intervals within easy reach of any of the more than 225,000 motorists who use the ten mile strip of freeway daily.

HE CAUTIONED all motorists that if they need help and are on the central section of the freeway they should lift the hood of their automobile as a distress signal and never attempt to cross the freeway to get to a telephone.

He pointed out that the freeway phone is free and that a motorist in trouble does not need a dime to operate it.

Hahn said he will recommend installation of the emergency phones on the San Diego Freeway and that eventually all freeways in the county will be so equipped.
