### Suit Filed For Damage At School

Parents of a youngster who started a fire in a Torrance school are being taken to court by the Torrance Unified School District. Board members authorized Robert W. Cosby, director of operations, to appear in small claims court on the district's behalf in an attempt to recoup \$74.20 for damages incurred in a book-burning episode at Magruder Elementary School. The court action was scheduled after parents ignored repeated requests by mail and telephone to make restitution.




