**Thespians Overcome Port Noise**

 "All the world is a stage . . . William Shakespeare once said. As if to prove the truth of Mr. Shakespeare's words, dedicated players have long been using a variety of locations for their performances. Plays have been presented in schools, churches, public parks, open fields, barns, cellars . . . in short anyplace where an audience could be gathered. In this tradition a new theater group has been formed in the South Bay area which presents their plays in a tent at the harbor's edge in Ports of Call Village. The Ports of Call Players' production of Noel Coward's comedy "Blithe Spirit" was presented to the accompaniment of sea breezes and harbor noises outside the tent. It is to the credit of the players that from the second act on, I do not remember hearing any harbor noises.
