

Financial Aid Now Available

Students entering California State College at Palos Verdes this fall will have available to them a variety of types of financial assistance. M. Milo Mills, dean of student affairs at the college, announced today that scholarships, loans, college work-study and part-time employment will be available to enrolled students.

Ten \$50 scholarships have been provided by the Dyer and Tofness Mortgage Co. Three of the scholarships will be available to freshmen entering in the fall term 1965.

To be eligible an applicant must plan to attend CSCPV full-time (12 or more units), and have at least a "B" average in high school work.

These scholarships are renewable each term for the full academic year 1965-66 and will also be available to freshmen entering in the winter and spring quarters.

THE COLLEGE has been authorized to distribute \$9,000 in loans under the National Defense Education Act of 1958. Loans are approved on the basis of the individual student's financial need. Both full-time and part-time students are eligible to apply.

An high school senior or transfer student applying for admission to the college may make an application for a National Defense Education Act loan, although no action will be taken on these applications until the student is fully admitted to the college.

Undergraduate students may borrow up to \$1,000 for college expenses in one year, with the amount determined by the extent of the individual's financial need. Repayment of the loan is begun one year after the borrower leaves the college, and must be completed within an 11-year period. No interest will be charged on loans prior to the beginning of the repayment period.

THE COLLEGE will have available approximately \$3,000 under the Economic Opportunity Act College Work-Study Program. To be approved for college work-study an applicant must demonstrate financial need in accordance with the criteria established by the Economic Opportunity Act.

For example, students from families now receiving welfare assistance generally are eligible. A maximum of 15 hours per week of on-campus work as library assistants, instructional assistants, switchboard operators and clerical assistants will be available to those who qualify. The rate of pay varies from \$1.25 to \$1.90 per hour.

The college will also maintain other part-time employment opportunities for students who wish to supplement their finances.

Garden Checklist

1. Last call for feeding camellias. Fertilize them with camellia food your C.A.N. nurseryman recommends, and then confine your care to regular watering and disbudding to encourage mammoth flowers.
2. Prune raspberries, loganberries and boysenberries by cutting to the ground canes that bore fruit this year, and loosely winding the new growth around the trellis.
3. Shade trees may be planted now and will develop a good root system before winter begins. The August sun will let you know where you need them. Specimen trees are available in containers now at your C.A.N. nursery. You can see what they look like in full leaf.
4. It isn't too early to start planting native shrubs and trees. The low, spreading varieties of ceanothus (Wild Lalac) make handsome ground covers and produce clusters of bright blue flowers in the spring.
5. For baskets of bloom in December, plant seeds of early-flowering Sweet Peas now. Sow the seeds thickly in rich soil, and cover the seed beds with wire until the seedlings are 4-6 inches high.

Theater at Observatory Continues Moon Voyage

Interstellar space is conquered in "A Trip to the Moon and Saturn" by means of a Zeiss projector at Griffith Park Observatory's planetarium theater, according to the Los Angeles City Recreation and Park Department.

Dr. Clarence H. Clemenshaw, Observatory director said that the hilltop scientific center is open every day of the week through Sept. 12, with shows scheduled at 3, 8 and 9:15 p.m. daily and extra presentations offered at 1:30 and 4:30 p.m. on weekends.

By means of multiple projectors that simulate movement through the solar system, audiences are taken from earth to a crater on the moon in an imaginary space vehicle. Space photos of the moon taken by Ranger 9 are utilized to simulate the approach to the dead satellite and a landing on the soft lunar surface.

FROM THERE the voyagers undertake another trip into space with a journey to Titan, a satellite of the planet Saturn. As the largest known moon of the ringed planet, Titan is heavy enough to have an atmosphere, and therefore blue skies, Dr. Clemenshaw said.

Admission to the theater is 75 cents for adults and 30 cents for students 5 to 18 years of age.
