



**Keep Vital Papers Near, VA Suggests**

Keep family documents such as birth and marriage certificates where they can be readily found. Mort Webster, manager of VA's Southern California Regional Office, advised veterans and their dependents today.

Webster said documents of this sort may be needed to support claims for veterans benefits and for other purposes.

These include military discharges or separation papers, death certificates, divorce decrees and guardianship or child custody evidence, he said.

Veterans claims which may require these documents include disability or death compensation or pension and burial benefits.
