### New Aide Named for Campaign

Mrs. Carol Greenberg has been named honorary women's chairman of the Harold Garvin for State Senator campaign in Harbor City. Garvin is seeking the Democratic nomination in the 32nd Senate District.

The announcement was made at a coffee for Garvin held at the Greenberg home, 24426 S. Alexandria.

In accepting the appointment, Mrs. Greenberg said Garvin is "a Democrat, who, after years of service as a volunteer in his community, is asking for a chance to go on to greater, and official, work as a senator in Sacramento."

Garvin, a political science instructor, has proposed new reforms which would cut the cost of political campaigns in California and allow more independent candidates to seek office.

He also called for tax relief for California's senior homeowners. "Taxes on homes have gone up so much here that many retired workers, living on pensions, and men and women living off Social Security are having to give up the homes they have lived in for most of their lives," Garvin said.

Garvin also called for schools, social welfare services, unions, and industries to cooperate in training now unemployed citizens to take such persons "off direct relief and give them jobs that will restore their dignity."

Mrs. Greenberg, an active Democrat in San Fernando Valley prior to moving to Harbor City, is a member of the Shoestring Democratic Club and is membership chairman of the area chapter of the American Civil Liberties Union.

### Root Speaks Out on State Property Tax

Harry Root, Candidate for State Senator in the 32nd District has called property tax in California outmoded, discriminatory, unfair, and economically destructive and regressive.

"Under the existing revenue system in our State, every California property owner faces the certainty that his local property taxes will continue to rise unabated year after year while he faces further tax increases at the State level," he said.

"Property taxes are a poor index of benefits received from our government, for there are many services performed by our government which are supported in large measure by the property tax, but in which the property owner receives little or no benefits," he said.

Root stressed that in his opinion the ownership of property is not a measure of ability of a person to pay a tax assessed against the property, especially property which is owned by our senior citizens.

"It is imperative that certain property tax reforms be instituted and that the revenue structure be altered by moving away from the property tax toward a more equitable form of taxation," Root maintained.

Root concluded by saying "I feel that we now need a shift from property taxes to other sources of tax revenue but only if a shift in taxes would not result in an unequal payment of taxes by any part of the residents of our State."

### City Storm Drain Gets 'Go Ahead'

A two-way agreement as a prelude to construction of a Torrance area storm drain project has been approved by County Supervisors according to Supervisor Kenneth Hahn.

Parties to the pact are the County Flood Control District and the City of Torrance. The agreement calls for the city to maintain existing retention basins on Henrietta and Entradero streets.

They will be utilized as part of line B of project 1105 which will be built by private contractors under district supervision.

Plans for the drainage facility are being prepared by Torrance. Project 1105 involves two major drainage lines and the retention basins will be utilized in regulating storm flows in the over-all system.

ONE LINE is tentatively scheduled to begin at the Pacific Ocean some 900 feet southwest of Harbor Drive in Redondo Beach, run in rights of way to Harbor, northeast in Herondo Street to the Santa Fe Railway, northeast in right of way for about 1,000 feet to Pacific Coast Highway and Anita Street, northeast in Anita to Flagler Lane, and east in 190th Street to Anza Avenue.

Line two will join the first in 190th Street and Cluster Lane, extend south in right of way to Del Amo Boulevard, and southwest in additional right of way to the Henrietta retention basin.

Financing for the project was included in the \$275 million bond issue approved in 1964, Hahn said.
