### Blood Urgently Needed As Stockpiles Dwindle

Vernon A. Lake has a special reason for donating blood for the Armed Forces: He donates in memory of his 19-year old son who was killed in South Viet Nam last October. Lake's most recent contribution was at the Red Cross bloodmobile visit to Inglewood last week, where he was joined by Robert Cannon, minister of the Inglewood Church of Christ, and five fellow members of the parish. When Lake heard Red Cross had been asked by the Defense Department to collect blood for the Armed Forces in Viet Nam, he said that donating a pint would be a small contribution "compared to what the boys over there are giving." Lake lives with his wife at 449 W. Fairview St. in Inglewood.

Those wishing to help meet the Department of Defense request as well as the on-going need for blood to treat the ill and injured at the 219 hospitals in Los Angeles and Orange Counties are urged to make donor appointments during June.

South Bay Red Cross volunteers will assist staff nurses and a physician in staffing the facility from 3 to 7:30 p.m.
