# 3-Year-Olds Compete In Argonaut Stakes

Three-year-old stars will take another turn in the Hollywood Park limelight Saturday in the 25th renewal of the \$30,000 added Argonaut

Stakes, an important prelude to the \$100,000 added Hollywood Derby on July 9.

The Argonaut Stakes could serve to sort out the top candidates in the three-year-old division, which boasts an abundance of talent this summer at the Inglewood track.

In the one-mile Will Rogers Stakes on Memorial Day, so many three-year-olds were entered, the race was split into two divisions, with Housels and Moore's Ri Tux and Frank M. McMahon's Aqua Vite emerging victorious.

Ri Tux, a hard-hitting but hitherto unlucky son of Have Tux, garnered the initial stakes triumph of his career in the opening section, while Aqua Vite, a son of Nashua, trained by Johnny Longden, won the first race of his life with his \$39 upset in the second division.

Both Ri Tux and Aqua Vite are expected back in action in the Argonaut Stakes, as are the Will Rogers Stakes hummers-up, Drin and Vague Image. The latter accounted for the \$28,900 Debonair Stakes earlier this summer.

Other likely Argonaut Stakes candidates include Postage, Earldom, Lin and Dominar.

Expected to make his seasonal debut in the Argonaut is Tragnieve, victor in the \$94,850 California Derby on April 23 at Golden Gate.
