## Patrol Beefs Up Labor Day Forces

California Highway Patrol Commissioner Bradford M. Crittenden said today that Labor Day holiday travelers are apt to notice an increase in the uniformed strength in the California Highway Patrol.

Crittenden said this as part of a joint statement with California Medical Association President Dr. James C. MacLaggan of San Diego, in which both urged California drivers to watch for symptoms of potential accidents. These they listed as: driving while sleepy or after drinking, or even when angry.

For his part, MacLaggan referred to the traffic accident as a major public health problem. Its staggering cost in human lives, misery and money has aroused increased concern in the medical community.

Crittenden indicated complete agreement with MacLaggan and said the Patrol has been authorized to double its force in order to help Californians with the problem.

"Some of these new men are already on freeways near metropolitan centers in California," said Crittenden, "and drivers will notice this increase on Labor Day weekend."

"The increase in manpower and the increased awareness of our mounting injury and death problem should serve to alert Californians to drive by all the rules of the road this Labor Day weekend, and on every day they drive."

## CHP Sets Final Date For Exams

The closing date for filing applications to take the California Highway Patrol civil service test for Traffic Officer is only two weeks away.

Captain P. J. Ford, commander of the South Los Angeles Area of the Patrol said today that the final date for filing applications is Sept. 16.

"Applications must be in by Sept. 16," Captain Ford said, "if prospective patrolmen are to take the written test on Oct. 15."

In addition to the written test, an oral examination is required of all persons successful in the written test.

"To qualify for the test you must be 21 to 31 years old, a high school graduate or the equivalent, in good health, no shorter than 5 feet 9 or taller than 6 feet 6, and a resident of this state for at least one year," Captain Ford said.

"The benefits and salary received by Patrolmen are very good. But, just as important is the knowledge that you are a member of an outstanding team that is devoted to increasing safety on our streets and highways."
