

Bids Due Friday for New Carson Area Drain System

Bids to construct additional drainage facilities in the Carson area are slated to be opened this Friday. The contract will be awarded by the Board of Supervisors about 10 days later. The project begins in 220th Street at Figueroa Street, runs east in 220th to Dolores Street, north in Dolores to Carson Street and east in Carson to Avalon Boulevard where it junctions with a previously completed project. Storm waters will be discharged into Dominguez Channel. Also included in the project is a short section which joins the second at Carson and Dolores and extends west in Carson to Orrick Avenue north.

A third part will include two lines in the Long Beach area. Construction involves about a mile and a half of reinforced concrete pipe and box drainage conduits. Work is due to start within two or three weeks after the contract award and will require approximately seven months to complete, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn said.


