1 1/2 C. grated cheese

Cook spaghetti until tender; drain. Add remaining ingredients, reserving 1/2 cup of the grated cheese. Mix lightly and pour into 2-qt. casserole. Sprinkle with the reserved 1/2 cup cheese. Cover and bake
