Compromise on Rumford Act Opposed by Realtors

Amendments to the Rumford Act now before the Legislature "are worse than the act itself," the president of the California Real Estate Association has declared.

Reed Robbins, CREA president, renewed his call for outright repeal of the Rumford Act "in accordance with the will of the people," as a more desirable alternative.

"The compromise bill adversely affects taxpayers of all races and religions," Robbins said. "The Fair Employment Practices Commission (FEPC), rena med, retains staggering powers, although an effort has been made to provide an alternative for court proceedings."

Research Grant to Pay For New Cancer Study

A grant of \$91,045 from the American Cancer Society will be used by Dr. Stanley G. Korenman, director of clinical research at Harbor General Hospital, to further his studies of the effects of hormones such as estrogen and progesterone on kinds of cancers that are influenced by the hormonal environment of the individual. Included in these are breast, prostate, and endometrial cancer.

His study will include study of the same hormones which are used in oral contraceptive agents which could lead to their use in treating cancers and of value in contraceptive drugs.

Highway Engineer To Quit

Retiring District 7 Engineer of the State Division of Highways Edward Telford will be honored at a banquet Aug. 9 in the Biltmore Hotel in Los Angeles.

Effective Oct. 1, Telford will retire after 40 years in highway work, with 11 years devoted to heading freeway building in the Los Angeles area.

Under his administration, more than 360 miles of full freeway have been opened in Los Angeles, Orange and Ventura counties. There are 440 miles of freeway serving five million motorists.

THE MAIN concern, Telford said, is to keep the freeway building program moving toward its 1,500 miles completion.

"Ultimately the traffic load may require double decking of freeways like the Santa Ana," he said.

"But we still need to provide more elements of the system, to give people a chance to travel more nearly in a straight line."

On his success he said, "Our accomplishments must be good or we wouldn't have so many customers."

New Water Line Wins Approval

A new pipeline which will improve water service for the Lomita area has been approved, Supervisor Burton W. Chace announced today.

The Board of Supervisors Tuesday allocated \$45,000 for construction of a new feeder line.

Funds for the project will come from revenues of County Waterworks District No. 13, which serves Lomita. The district is in the West Basin Municipal Water District, member agency of the Metropolitan Water District.

Lomita presently receives Colorado River water through connections with MWD's Palos Verdes feeder line. The MWD has completed plans for the construction of a third line, which will pass through the Lomita area.

"A Lomita connection with this proposed feeder will provide residents in that area with an improvement in water service," Chace said. "It will upgrade the reliability of the system."
