## 34,400 Expected In City Schools

Double sessions will be a thing of the past this fall when a record-breaking 34,432 students return to Torrance schools Wednesday, Sept. 13.

Although enrollment is up 519 students over last fall, there will be no double sessions due to the opening of two new elementary schools, Sam Levy School, 3420 229th Place, and Grace Wright School, 3915 Spencer St.

Included in the predicted enrollment, according to Paul Mackey, special services staff consultant, are 24,429 elementary students and 10,003 high school students, representing an increase of 31 elementary and 488 high school students over a year ago.

South High, which boasts the largest student body, with an anticipated enrollment of 2,950, will actually gain the least number of new students of the city's four high schools. Increase expected at South is 62 students.

Biggest increase will be at the district's smallest high school, West, which will pick up 224 students this fall, bringing its total enrollment to 2,073.

Torrance High, which passed the 2,000 mark last year, will gain 88 students this fall, with enrollment predicted at the 2,238 figure.

North High, which opens its remodeled gym this fall, expects an additional 124 students over a year ago, hitting a new high of 2,742 students.

On the elementary school level, Victor School remains the district's largest school enrollmentwise, despite the loss of 253 students to the new Grace Wright School.

Also topping the 1,000 figure will be Wood Elementary School with 1,029 pupils and Hickory School with 1,004 youngsters.

Levy and Wright, the two new schools, expect enrollments of 491 and 437 students, respectively.

## City High Schools Set Dates for Registration

Registration dates for new students at the four high schools in the Torrance Unified School District were announced this week by Dr. Bruce Wagner, curriculum consultant. Classes resume Wednesday, September 13.

New students residing in the North High School attendance area may register September 1 through September 8. Registration at South High School will take place August 30 through September 8. Torrance High and West High will register new students August 28 through September 8.

## Fall Term Will Open In Gardena

Gardena Christian School will begin its fall term Sept. 11, with classes for students from kindergarten through sixth grade.

Gardena Christian School is an inter-denominational religious school and welcomes all faiths to enroll.

The school is located at 1473 W. 182nd St., Gardena, and is sponsored by the Bethesda Assembly of God Church.

All registration offices will open from 9 a.m. to noon and 1 to 3 p.m. on dates indicated. Students who attended elementary or high schools in Torrance last year are not required to re-register.

New high school students are asked to report to the counseling office of the high school in their attendance areas for help in planning their programs for the coming year.

Parents of new students are asked to bring polio immunization verification, names and addresses of previous schools attended and report cards or records from the previous school, information regarding student's birthplace and birthdate, and the name of the parents' place of employment, address, and phone number.

High school locations are: North High, 3260 W. 182nd St.; South High, 4801 Pacific Coast Highway; Torrance High, 2200 W. Carson St.; and West High, 20401 Victor St.

Registration of new elementary school students will be conducted September 1 through September 13 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Schools will be closed for registration on Labor Day, September 4.


