

Clinic Wins Praise of Supervisor

Successful efforts of the Carson Chamber of Commerce to vaccinate dogs in the Carson area against rabies have been praised by Supervisor Kenneth Hahn.

The anti-rabies clinic, conducted Aug. 3, was spearheaded by John Calas, chairman of the health, welfare, and adult education committee for the chamber.

A total of 1,249 dogs in the Torrance, Wilmington, and Carson area were vaccinated at the clinic.

"The Carson area has long taken the lead in showing communities what can be done to protect the health of our pets, and in the long run, of our citizens," Hahn said.
