

Senate Makes Changes In Committee Line-Up

SACRAMENTO—The state senate made a number of changes in committee personnel just before adjournment Sept. 8, primarily to fill vacancies.

The changes also took care of the senate's newest member, Senator Milton Marks (R-San Francisco). They were announced by Senator Hugh M. Burns (D-Fresno), president pro tempore and chairman of the rules committee, which makes committee appointments.

Senator John G. Schmitz (R-Tustin) was appointed to the powerful finance committee, replacing the late Senator J. Eugene McAteer (D-San Francisco). Senator Ralph C. Dills (D-Torrance) also was appointed to finance. He will replace Burns who said his duties make it impossible for him to devote sufficient time to the finance committee.

Senator Fred W. Marler Jr. (R-Redding) was appointed to fill McAteer's seat on the important governmental efficiency committee. Senator Nicholas C. Petris (D-Oakland) was named to McAteer's

Peninsula Land Fill Half Full

More than 4.7 million tons of refuse have been placed in the Palos Verdes Landfill Project since it was opened in 1957, according to Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

The figures were revealed in an annual report to the Board of Supervisors yesterday.

"As of May 1, 1967, approximately 42 per cent of the total site capacity has been filled," Chace said. This project is adjacent to Hawthorne Boulevard, near the Torrance southern city limit.

When filled, the site will be used for recreation purposes and dedicated as a regional park.

Portions of the site are now used by the Rolling Hills Pony League, the Pop Warner Football Association, and the Rolling Hills Estates Municipal Stable.


