Rosh Hashonah, the Jewish New Year, marks the beginning of the Ten Days of Repentance, the holiest days in the Jewish calendar. With repentance and prayer the New Year is ushered in with renewed dedication to return to the path of upright living in harmony with what the Almighty wants man to do and be.

Rosh Hashonah is also known as the Day of Judgment when, according to the new cantor, Salo Blumenthal, all whose inspirational chanting people pass before the Creator in judgment like sheep before the Shepherd.

The climax of the Ten Days of Repentance is Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement. Yom Kippur is a day of fasting, prayer and meditation, for while on Rosh Hashonah, the judgment is inscribed, on Yom Kippur the judgment is sealed.
