## Garden Checklist

1. Most gladioli are ready to lift by now, even the late blooming ones. When the tops brown, lift them and cut the stalks about an inch above the corm. Store corms in cool, dry place until next year.
2. Before storing gladioli corms for the winter, it is a good idea to dust them with an insecticide.
3. Stop watering Tuberous Begonias gradually and let the tops die back. They'll separate from the tubers easily in a few weeks.
4. New lawns should be kept moist at all times. Don't count on fall rains.
5. Among the many perennials for planting this month are the colorful Fibrous Begonias. These are ideal for borders and edgings.
