

Revival Meetings Planned


Revival services will be held at the Narbonne Avenue Baptist Church next week with the Rev. Dr. Robert D. Hughes as guest speaker.

Law Enforcement Forum Scheduled Here Friday

Police officials from five counties and the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department will answer questions at a unique public forum on "Law Enforcement and Civil Liberties" Friday, 7:30 p.m., at the Torrance YMCA, 2900 W. Sepulveda Blvd.

Explaining police policy and practices in the area will be representatives of the police departments of Torrance, Redondo Beach, Hermosa Beach, Hawthorne, and El Segundo and the Lennox Sheriff's Station.

Also on the program will be Loren Miller Jr., chief of the Constitutional Rights Section, Los Angeles Attorney General's Office, and Harold H. Nibbrig of the American Civil Liberties Union.

Written questions will be discussed by the police chiefs.
