Expansion Of Center Approved

Expansion of the Newton Pacific Shopping Center in Torrance will get under way following approval of a \$280,000 long-term loan by Centinela Valley Bank of Inglewood, bank president Rowan Henry has announced.

The loan covers refinancing of two existing buildings which house various specialty shops plus a state Department of Rehabilitation office, and funds for the construction of a two-story, 11,208-square-foot structure that will contain seven shops on the ground level and eight office suites on the second floor.

Located in the 3100 block of Pacific Coast Highway near Newton Street, the shopping center also will expand its parking area to accommodate 113 cars.
