Don't Stop Officers, CHP Says

Local motorists were urged today not to stop California Highway Patrol traffic officers out on the freeway simply to have them clear written warnings acquired earlier in a vehicle inspection lane.

"In the first place, it is unlawful to stop on a freeway for anything other than emergency purposes," declared California Highway Patrol Captain P. J. Ford of South Los Angeles Area.

"In the second place, it is an unsafe thing to do." The mechanical warning is a written notice which states an equipment violation exists and requires it to be corrected within a given number of days. When the violation is corrected the notice must be cleared off the books by the patrol.

Ford pointed out the mechanical warnings can be cleared at the local California Highway Patrol office or freeway.

Savers Get Checks for Christmas






