During the past weeks I have received several requests for do-it-yourself tours on RTD lines. The idea definitely has possibilities. The RTD operates 2200 miles of lines in four counties and that represents a lot of sight-seeing in any man's book. Many of these places would require a full day, especially on the weekend when service is less frequent. However, any tours I've ever been on never tried for a speed record. Think about it and if it tickles your fancy, drop me a line.

The Los Alamitos Race Track has opened its cash register on a brand new season of quarter-horse racing, November 21. Not being a member of the win, place or show set, I wouldn't know if a quarter horse was a pint-sized nag or a two-bit version of the two-dollar bet. Nevertheless, the RTD is offering good service on Line 37 from the new terminal in Los Angeles commencing at 10:15 a.m. (10:00 a.m. on Saturdays). Frequent service will be operated as needed.

As Christmas time approaches, many business districts go all out with street decorations. One of the most outstanding of these is Hollywood Boulevard. If you have never seen the decorations along Hollywood Boulevard, you are in for a treat. Each year between Argyle and La Brea, every light standard becomes a revolving lighted Christmas tree. The best way to enjoy this electronic northwoods is to ride down Hollywood Boulevard by RTD bus. Lines 89-91 and 85 all serve the Boulevard. Many connecting lines provide service from all parts of the city.

Q.—We live near Carson and Avalon and would like to go to Busch Gardens. How would we go from Los Angeles as we don't know how to get there? Also what would the fare be? E.B.

A.—Get off the 37 Line at 5th Street and walk three blocks west to Hill Street. Board a 93 bus going north and ride to Roscoe Boulevard in Van Nuys. Change to a 16 Line west to Busch Gardens. The fare one way is 91c including your transfer.

Q. We live near Yukon and Artesia and would like to go to places like Disneyland, Knotts, Marineland and Los Angeles. Al C.

A. You can catch the RTD 101 Line on Artesia and ride west to Hawthorne, change to the 5 Line going north to Los Angeles. To go to Disneyland or Knotts, walk east on 8th to the new RTD Terminal and board a 58 bus. I'll send you the proper timetables. Have fun!

Q. How do I get from 138th and Hawthorne to Griffith Park and St. George Street, Los Angeles? John A. R.

Catch the 5 Line on Hawthorne going north and ride to 5th Street in Los Angeles, walk one block to Hill Street and transfer to the 91 or 94. Ride to Sunset and Parkman and change to the 78 Line that will take you to Griffith Park and St. George.

Q. How can I get to my daughter's house at 1700 Maple Grove, West Covina, from West Plymouth, Inglewood? Mrs. V. P.

A. As near as I can tell by my map, you are not far from La Tijera. Catch the 51 Line on La Tijera to 6th and Main Street in Los Angeles and walk one block east to the terminal. Board the RTD 60 Line east to Azusa Ave. That is as close as you can get by Public Transportation. I'll send you a map and timetables.
