## Place That Call Early, Telephone Manager Says

With that thought in mind, Harold Nelms, South Bay division manager for General

Busiest time for the long distance lines is between Christmas Eve through the morning of Dec. 26, the local manager said.

Standard night and late-night long distance rates will prevail during the three-day holiday, Nelms said. The rates will be in effect between 7 p.m. Friday and 7 a.m. next Tuesday.
