

A progress report on the studies leading up to a general plan for the Palos Verdes Peninsula has been released by Supervisor Burton W. Chace.

Chace revealed that county planning staff members will wind up meetings with interested groups next month, then conduct a public opinion poll before a background report is finalized.

"In addition, their opinions will be sought in a poll we plan to make in January."

"COUNTY planning representatives have met with nine groups so far to determine the status of present land use and some of their thinking as to the future," Chace said.

These groups include the League of Women Voters, the Palos Verdes Advisory Council (which represents 34 Peninsula homeowners associations), the Oceanview Homeowners, and representatives of Palos Verdes Estates, Rolling Hills, and Rolling Hills Estates.

background-gathering phase of the study is set Jan. 3 with the Palos Verdes Peninsula Chamber of Commerce.

THE GENERAL plan is being prepared at the instruction of Chace in an effort to update the county's planning and zoning concepts for the Peninsula," Chace said.

"The general plan will be used as a guide by the county in determining the growth pattern for the unincorporated section of the Peninsula," Chace said. "However, our close work with planners from the three incorporated cities will assure us of a plan that is compatible with the entire Peninsula," Chace said.

The Peninsula is one of the fastest growing sections of the county. The population in 1966 was 53,000 and is expected to rise to 85,000 by 1980. There were 15,522 dwelling units on the Peninsula in 1966, and this total is expected to climb to 25,000 by 1980.

When the report is completed, the Regional Planning Commission will meet with Peninsula organizations and associations at several public meetings and come up with a preliminary plan.

THE PRELIMINARY plan will be released to community leaders and association representatives at a meeting tentatively scheduled for March. At that time, the plan will be taken under study by the Regional Planning Commission and Peninsula leaders. A public hearing, tentatively set for next July, will be held by the Regional Planning Commission before the final general plan is adopted.


