Pipeline Contract Awarded

The Board of Directors of the Metropolitan Water District has awarded a contract in the amount of \$8,376,595 to Steve P. Rados, Inc., for the construction of a large water delivery line in southern Los Angeles County. The pipeline will extend from Alameda Street west to the district's Palos Verdes Reservoir. It will be constructed through portions of the cities of Los Angeles, Lomita, Torrance, and Rolling Hills Estates and in unincorporated areas. The line will be nearly 10 miles in length and six and one-half feet in diameter. It will be the final link in the district's Second Lower Feeder system. Along its length, the feeder will be interconnected to many other parts of the district's existing distribution system. Construction of the final segment is expected to start soon after the first of the additional service to areas year and is to be completed late in 1969.
