

Air Force Selects Black-Foxe School

Black-Foxe School, long a landmark in the history of Southern California education, has been selected to host an Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) unit beginning in September of this year.

Word of this nomination was recently made public by U.S. Senator George Murphy, who also pointed out that Black-Foxe was the only military school of 50 schools selected from across the nation.

AN AIR FORCE letter recently received by Col. John F. Babcock, UAS (Ret), president of the school, states that the selection of Black-Foxe "indicates the exceptional nature of your educational program, and your interest in the Air Force aerospace education course."

Brig. Gen. Donald F. Plake, commandant of the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps, said that "many excellent high schools throughout the nation were visited in order to find those which meet our complex criteria. You are to be honored that you successfully met our requirements."

SENATOR Murphy made the announcement at a luncheon hosted by the TRW Systems at Redondo Beach.

Attending the luncheon along with Senator Murphy and Colonel Babcock were TRW president Dr. Ruben F. Mettler, and Black-Foxe board of trustee members William D. Tetsch, Kenneth Fisher, John Preis, Milton B. Scott, and Lewis Whitney.
