Committee For Awards Selected

An eight-member selection committee to choose Redondo Beach's top citizen of 1966 will meet at 4 p.m. June 28, according to President Corwin H. Eberting Jr., of its sponsoring Redondo Beach Chamber of Commerce.

The "Young Man" winners are not included as they are eligible for "Man of the Year" honors.
