Home Loan Deadline for World War II Vets Near

The G. I. Home Loan program for World War II veterans comes to an end July 25, the county Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs warned today.

All loan guarantee applications, accompanied by the veterans' certificate of eligibility, must be received by the Veterans Administration prior to the July 25 cutoff date. These forms are normally submitted by the proposed lender.

SUPERVISOR Kenneth Hahn, chairman of Military and Veterans' Affairs, cautioned veterans that the certificate of eligibility itself is not considered a loan application. "The certificate only indicates the individual's maximum period of eligibility," Hahn said. "It has no effect until he applies for a specific loan."

Eligibility for World War II veterans has been expiring according to a formula based upon the individual's discharge date and length of service. However, all entitlement will terminate July 25, regardless of the date of discharge.

VETERANS discharged for service-connected disabilities

and widows of veterans whose death was service-connected are eligible until the deadline date.

Expiration of the World

War II program does not affect veterans of the Korean conflict or those who have served since January 31, 1955.
