

# 8,600 Youngsters Enroll In Learn-to-Swim Classes

More than 8,600 children are learning to swim free at County pools in "Operation Big Dip" initiated by Supervisor Kenneth Hahn. The free swimming instruction is given during morning hours at all county pools and regular minimum fees (from 15 to 25 cents depending on age) are waived for youngsters who sign up for classes. Hahn emphasized that reg-

istrations are still open at every County swimming pool for the free program. He said that of the approximately 950,000 young people, age 19 and under, in Los Angeles County, an estimated 70 per cent of them (660,000) do not know how to swim adequately to save their own or someone else's life. He stressed that by open-

ing the pools free for swimming instruction by qualified lifeguards, children will be encouraged to learn this vital skill for pleasure and safety. Last summer, a total of 13,500 youngsters received swimming instruction in a pilot project of "Operation Big Dip" which was expanded County-wide this year.

# Burglar Gets \$410 in Loot

A burglar took \$410, including 10 cartons of cigarettes, from the home of Christine Bair, 1744 Hickory Ave., Saturday after entering the house by breaking through a screen door. Although the entire house was ransacked, police said, only currency and cigarettes were taken. The money was found by the thief in a bedroom hiding place during the daylight burglary.

# Rainwater Problems Go Right Down the Drain

Vital storm drain facilities to relieve areas of Torrance during heavy rains will soon be under construction, according to Supervisor Kenneth Hahn. A \$848,976 contract was awarded Kral - Masanovich yesterday by the Board of Supervisors. Due for construction are projects 741 and 8103 with an over-all length of about four miles. Reinforced concrete box and pipe drainage conduits will be installed.

Work is expected to get under way within the next two or three weeks and will require approximately a year to complete, Hahn said. The projects involve work in portions of Crenshaw Boulevard, Hawaii Avenue, Maricopa Street, Maple Avenue, El Dorado Street, Elm Avenue, Greenwood Avenue, Fern Avenue, Mariposa Street, Amie Street, Garnet Street, Plaza Del Amo, Jefferson Street, and various rights of way.

# Carson Street Work Approved

Widening the Carson Street from the Harbor Freeway to Orrick Avenue will be under way soon, bringing another major highway improvement to the Carson area, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn said today. A contract for \$453,634 was awarded this week to Sully-Miller Contracting Co., lowest of six bidders. Construction is slated for completion in December.

WORK ON the 3/4-mile-long section of Carson Street will consist of reconstructing and widening the roadway to provide a multi-lane highway within a 100-foot right of way. Sections of Figueroa Street, Moneta Avenue, and Main Street in the vicinity of Carson Street will also be improved as a part of the project.

IT ALSO will include the modernization of traffic signals on Carson Street at its intersections with Figueroa Street, Main Street, and Moneta Avenue, and highway safety lighting will be installed at the Carson Street-Main Street intersection. Construction on Carson Street from Normandie Avenue to the Harbor Freeway was completed in January of this year.

# Class for ABC Agents Scheduled

Kirby, state director of alcoholic beverage control, has announced a series of training courses will be held this month for enforcement agents throughout the state. Kirby, who assumed the ABC post after retiring with 25 years of service with the FBI, and who has appointed two of his top three administrators from the ranks of the FBI, said the courses will be conducted by FBI instructors.

They will include lectures on the law of arrest, on search and seizure, rules of evidence and other technical points of ABC enforcement agents need to know. Hearings were held in Los Angeles and Sacramento this week and will be held in Los Angeles and San Francisco on July 17-19; in Fresno on July 25-27 and again in San Francisco on July 24-26. Meanwhile Kirby has been making the rounds of various organizations and groups within the alcoholic beverage industry, letting it be known that he will insist on full compliance with the law. The training program is intended to equip the department personnel to carry out this aim.
